Year 7 to Year 9

I went to a meeting on Wednesday with the DFE, Trust, LA representatives and the leaders of the receiving schools. I queried where the application process was up to as parents were unsure what was happening. There has been some applications 'in year' and others for a September start. It was decided that to ensure fairness the local authorities are going to look at current places in schools against the preferences (deadline is 31st October). They can then see the first preferences and look at current capacity and potential capacity for later this year or for September. The aim is to plan first preference places for as many students as possible. They will work with the schools to move students sooner if there is capacity to do so. I will keep you updated as this progresses. The local authorities should be contacting parents who have made an in year application to let them know what is happening.

Please email enquiry for my attention if you have any further queries or need help with the local authority admissions process.

SEND Students with EHCPs

We have asked the local authorities for updates on the placing of students. If you are contacted by the LA SEND team with a confirmed school or receive an offer of a school place from the LA please let us know and we can start to organise the appropriate transition for your child, working with the receiving school's SEND team.
