Update – school closure.

We are hoping that the local authorities have now contacted you with school placement information, they said by the end of the week! If you have not heard by Monday 9th December please let us know on our enquiry email and we will follow this up with the local authority teams.

We are aware that most of our students with EHCPs are still waiting for information from the North Yorkshire and East Riding SEND teams. We have asked for an urgent update.

The receiving schools will be contacting you with information on their induction programmes and starting dates.

Some schools are admitting students in January. We will ensure that any student leaving us at Christmas has an opportunity for a special farewell with their friends in the last week of term. We are meeting with representatives from each school to pass over important information and ensure a good start for students joining other schools.

To ensure that the majority of students have their first choice of school there will be some students who wished to leave now but will be admitted to their new school later next term or in September. When we get a fuller picture we will communicate the plans to everyone.

For the students who remain with us, they will continue with our timetable and curriculum. We are adapting some aspects to ensure we are in line with the receiving schools.
